

Background

Chief Engineer (Com.) NBPDCCL on 24.03.2017 filed a petition before the Commission for regulatory approval of the draft agreement forms for HT an LT consumers under clause 7.13 (2) of Bihar Electricity Supply Code 2007. At the time of admission of the case, it was detected that the petitioner NBPDCCL had not filed the draft format of the agreement for LT consumers along with the petition. The Commission also found that SBPDCL had not filed any such petition though the issue is equally applicable to SBPDCL too. When asked by the Commission about the reasons for SBPDCL absence in the proposal, the Chief Engineer (Com.) SBPDCL who was present during hearing on 25.04.2017, stated that they also endorsed the proposal as envisaged in the NBPDCCL's petition and further under took that they would also file similar proposal before the Commission on 05.05.2017. Accordingly, NBPDCCL vide its letter no 6114 dated 27.04.2017 submitted a draft format of the agreement for LT consumers. Similarly SBPDCL, also filed the petition enclosing New HT & LT agreement form before the Commission for its approval vide its letter 461 dated 27.04.2017.

The Commission clubbing the petitions of NBPDCCL & SBPDCL admitted the applications on 05.05.2017. Commission having felt the need of Comments/Suggestions/ Objections of the General Public & Stakeholders on the issue, directed its secretariat to publish a public notice in three daily News Papers- Two in Hindi and One in English having wide circulation in the State, inviting Comments/Suggestions/Objections from General Public & Stakeholders. It was also directed to upload the petition on the websites of both the DISCOMS (NBPDCCL & SBPDCL) and Commission.

Hearings

The case was heard on various dates viz. dt. 06.06.2017, 16.06.2017 and 30.06.2017.

No Comments/Suggestions/Objections were received from anyone. However, on 16.06.2017 Shri Krishna Kumar Agarwal representing Bihar Chamber of Commerce submitted that he would submit Comments/Suggestions/Objections after consultation in the meeting of Bihar Chamber of Commerce, but he did not file the same and the case was kept reserved for order on 30.06.2017.

Commissions View

Commission examined the proposed New HT and LT Agreement Form to be approved by it. It was submitted on behalf of the petitioners NBPDCCL & SBPDCL that the existing format of HT and LT Agreement Form which was notified in 2007 contains several clauses of BESC 2007. These clauses had been amended time to time and are no longer applicable. Therefore the Agreement Form under question need suitable amendment as well. It was also submitted that there is requirement of regulatory approval of the New HT and LT Agreement Form under Bihar Electricity Supply Code 2007 before replacing it with old one. It was asserted that the proposed New HT an LT Agreement Form will simplify the terms and conditions of the Agreement Form and would be easily acceptable to the consumers and the licensee.

Commission also finds that no Comments/Suggestions/Objections have been received either form the General Public or the Stakeholders. Nor did the representative of the Bihar Chamber of Commerce Shri Krishna Kumar Agarwal fulfil its assurance to file Comments/Suggestions/Objections after getting it discussed with the members of Bihar Chamber of Commerce. It is evident that there is no objection from any corner regarding approval of the proposed New HT and LT Agreement Form. The Commission agrees with the submissions of the DISCOMS that the New HT and LT Agreement is in consonance with the
